Alyeska Pipeline Service Company formed in 1970 to design, build, maintain and operate the Trans Alaska Pipeline System. The pipeline today is recognized as a landmark engineering feat and remains essential to Alaska's economy and central to the state's industry.

The Trans Alaska Pipeline System (TAPS) remains a living testament to the powerful Alaska spirit that has written our state's history and is fueling Alaska's future. Today, about 750 people are employed by Alyeska, a transportation service company that operates on behalf of the four TAPS owner companies, and hundreds of contractors work along TAPS at any given time. More than 96 percent of Alyeska's workforce lives in Alaska; about 20 percent of that workforce is Alaska Native; and 70 percent of TAPS contractor companies are based in Alaska.

This guide provides general information about Alyeska's largest contractors, all of which have programs in place that focus on recruiting and training a diverse workforce for jobs on TAPS. Available positions vary and individuals who are interested in working on TAPS must contact the contractors directly to inquire about current positions.

Pipeline Maintenance:

HCC's maintenance services include oil and gas pipelines in process and transportation facilities. The work includes conducting major repairs to the crude oil tanks and oil loading berths, repairs to and replacement of corroded large bore mainline pipe and valve components, and upgrades to complex electrical, communications, and mechanical systems. HCC also provides complete materials logistics, Operator Qualification (OQ) training, and human resources to meet federal regulations, as well as oil spill contingency response teams.

Equipment Services: HCC's fleet includes heavy construction equipment and specialized pipeline equipment.
